14cm (5½in) craft wire, 2mm thick

PVA glue

Availability patterns

On Sunday December 1st at 10:00am CET, the first pattern will be released, along with a printable PDF for the nativity stable. From then on, a new pattern will be available every other day. Christmas means gifts, so these patterns are all free! The calendar on the previous page shows the release date per pattern.

Gauge/Tension

Tension is not critical for this project, but different measurements may result in different yarn amounts needed. Make sure stuffing is not visible through fabric.

Measurements

Measurements are stated in the instructions of each figurine.

Notes

This pattern is worked using amigurumi method unless otherwise stated. Work sts continuously in a spiral without closing each round with ss. Mark first st of each round with sm, moving it up as you go.

Base pattern for human bodies is worked from bottom up, starting by making two Legs which are joined to make Body. Arms are attached as you work, and Skirt is worked directly on Body. See colour information in instructions per figurine.

When working in rows, turn after each row. Beg-ch do not count as sts.

Abbreviations (UK terms)

blo back loop only: insert hook under back loop only

ch(s) chain(s) or chain st(s)

ch-sp(s) chain space(s)

cont continue

dc double crochet

dc2tog double crochet 2 together to decrease by 1 st: (insert hook in next st, yoh, pull up loop) twice, yoh, draw through all loops

dtr double treble crochet

flo front loop only: insert hook under front loop only

htr half treble crochet

htr2tog half treble crochet 2 sts together to decrease by 1 st: (yoh, insert hook in next st/sp, yoh, pull up loop) twice, yoh, draw through all loops

LPdcB loop double crochet in back: wrap yarn from front to back over index finger of hand holding working yarn, insert hook in next stitch, grab yarn from behind index finger and draw yarn through stitch, yoh and draw yarn through both loops on hook and release loop

LPdcF loop double crochet in front:

wrap yarn around thumb of hand holding working yarn, make loop of approx 1cm (½in) and bring to front of work, 1 dc in next st, with loop placed between previous st and hook

open opening(s)

rem remaining

RS right side

sk skip(ped)

sm stitch marker(s)

SPdc spike double crochet: work a dc in the given st one round below

ss slip stitch(es)

st(s) stitch(es)

surface ss with RS facing, keep yarn

on WS, insert hook from RS to WS

between first and second st, yoh, pull

up loop to RS, insert hook from front

to back between second and third st,

yoh, pull up loop to RS, draw through

loop on hook to create ss. Cont across

round, making 1ss over each st

tog together

tr treble crochet

yoh yarn over hook

(.....) x times/to end work the

Base pattern human bodies

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Base Pattern | HUMAN BODIES

Base Pattern Human Bodies

Note: keep this Base Pattern for Human Bodies on hand as you will need it for several figurines.

Measurements

Height: 12cm (4¾in)

Gauge/Tension

Abbreviations

See Project Info document

Instructions

Arm (make 2)

Make magic ring.

Round 1 (RS) 7dc into ring. [7 dc]

Rounds 2 (RS)-11 1dc in each st around.

Do not stuff. Flatten opening and work next row through both layers to close.

Row 12 3dc, leave 1 st unworked, fasten off. [4 dc]

Leg (make 2)

Make magic ring.

Round 1 (RS) 6dc into ring. [6 dc]

Round 2 (RS) (1dc, 2dc in next st) 3 times. [9 dc]

Rounds 3-9 1dc in each st around.

Fasten off first Leg.

Make second Leg, but do not fasten off. Stuff legs firmly. Cont with Body.

Body

Round 10 Ch2, join to first Leg with 1dc in any st, 8dc, 2dc in each ch, 9dc on second Leg, 2dc in each ch on other side of chs. [26 dc]

Round 11 4dc, 2dc in next st, 12dc, 2dc in next st, 8dc. [28 dc]

Rounds 12-14 1dc in each st around.

Round 15 1dc blo in each st around.

Round 16 (12dc, dc2tog) twice. [26 dc]

Round 17 5dc, dc2tog, 11dc, dc2tog, 6dc. [24 dc]

Rounds 18-19 1dc in each st around.

Round 20 (10dc, dc2tog) twice. [22 dc]

Round 21 4dc, dc2tog, 9dc, dc2tog, 5dc. [20 dc]

Round 22 1dc in each st around.

Arms are attached in next round.

Round 23 2dc, dc2tog, 3dc through both sts of Arm and Body, dc2tog, 3dc, dc2tog, 3dc through both sts of Arm and Body, dc2tog, 1dc. [16 dc]
Stuff Body firmly.

Round 24 (Dc2tog) 8 times. [8 dc]

Round 25 1dc in each st around.

Cont with Head.

Head

Round 26 2dc in each st around. [16 dc]

Round 27 2dc in each st around. [32 dc]

Round 28 1dc in each st around.

Round 29 (3dc, 2dc in next st) 8 times.

[40 dc]

Rounds 30-39 1dc in each st around.

Stuff Head firmly.

Round 40 (8dc, dc2tog) 4 times.

[36 dc]

Round 41 (4dc, dc2tog) 6 times. [30 dc]

Round 42 (3dc, dc2tog) 6 times.

[24 dc]

Round 43 (2dc, dc2tog) 6 times. [18 dc]

Round 44 (1dc, dc2tog) 6 times. [12 dc]

Round 45 (Dc2tog) 6 times. [6 dc]

Fasten off. Pull yarn tail through rem 6 sts and pull tightly to close.

Skirt

Hold Body upside down. Join yarn with ss (does not count as st) to back of Body to one of the unworked front loops from Round 14. Start next round in same st.

Round 1 (RS) 1dc flo in each st around. [28 dc]

Round 2 (RS) (6dc, 2dc in next st) 4 times. [32 dc]

Rounds 3-4 1dc in each st around.

Round 5 (15dc, 2dc in next st) twice. [34 dc]

Rounds 6-7 1dc in each st around.

Round 8 7dc, 2dc in next st, 16dc, 2dc in next st, 9dc. [36 dc]

Rounds 9-10 1dc in each st around.

Round 11 (17dc, 2dc in next st) twice. [38 dc]

Rounds 12-13 1dc in each st around.

Round 14 1ss in each st around, fasten off.

Round 15 Work surface ss on top of

Round 14.

Weave in all ends.

Face Details

Eyes

Embroider 2 vertical lines over Rounds 32-33 for each Eye, 7 sts apart.

Nose

Embroider 2 vertical lines over Rounds 32-34 between Eyes, then wrap yarn 7 times around vertical lines.

Cheeks

Embroider 2 horizontal lines between Rounds 31-32 next to Eyes, 1 st wide.

Hair Cap

Make magic ring.

Round 1 (RS) 6dc into ring. [6 dc]

Round 2 (RS) (2dc in next st) 6 times. [12 dc]

Round 3 (1dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times. [18 dc]

Round 4 (2dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times. [24 dc]

Round 5 (3dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times. [30 dc]

Round 6 (4dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times. [36 dc]

Round 7 (5dc, 2dc in next st) 6 times. [42 dc]

Rounds 8-14 1dc in each st around.

Do not fasten off, see individual pattern per figurine for instructions for further hair details.
