

#### INSTRUCTIONS

#### BORDER

Note: when making Border, a slight gap may form at each of the joins, this should close when Ss Surface Crochet Detail has been worked at end. Also, each Square and short side of Triangle will have 19 sts and ch-2 sps to work in, and the long side of Triangles 26 sts and ch-2 sps. For a tidier Border, catch the joining as well as the blo of the first ch after each joining, but do not add a st in the Motifs, only in the joining.

Round 1 (RS) Join Yarn I with standing htr blo in first ch at any cnr, \*ch1, 210htr blo, rep from \* 3 more times, omit last htr, fasten off using nj. [840 htr (210 per side), 4 cnr ch-1 sps] Round 2 (RS) Rejoin Yarn I with standing dc in any cnr ch-1 sp, \*ch1, 1dc in same cnr, 210BPdc to end, 1dc in ch-sp; rep from \* 3 more times omit last dc, fasten off using nj. [210 BPdc per side, (1dc, ch1, 1dc) in each cnr; in total: 840 BPdc, 8 dc, 4 cnr ch-1 sps]

Note: for Round 3 use remnants of colours in an order that suits your preference. Samples use order as shown in Colour Placement Charts.

When changing colour, work pc sts as normal until last pc of chosen colour. For last pc, pull

new colour through in last step of 4th tr, close pc with new colour, ch3, sk 2 dc, pc in next st. **Round 3** Join colour of choice with beg pc in dc before any cnr, \*ch4, sk cnr ch-1 sp and 1 dc, (1pc, ch3, sk 2 BPdc) 70 times, 1pc (this pc is in the first dc of cnr '1dc, ch1, 1dc'); rep from \* 3 more times, omit last pc, fasten off using nj. [284 pc, 284 ch-3 sps, 4 cnr ch-4 sps] Round 4 Join Yarn I with standing dc over Round 3 ch-3 and into Round 2 BPdc just before last pc on any side, FPss around pc, \*(1dc, 1htr, ch1, 1htr, 1dc) in cnr ch-1 sp from Round 2 and over Round 3 ch-4 sp, FPss around pc, (2dc over Round 3 ch-3 sp and into Round 2 BPdc, FPss around pc) 70 times; rep from \* 3 more times, omit last dc and FPss, fasten off using nj. [568 dc, 8 htr, 284 FPss, 4 cnr ch-1 sps]

#### Ss Surface Crochet Detail

Using Yarn I, work ss blo at base of each htr blo st made in Round 1 of Border as follows: with yarn held at WS, insert hook from front to back in any cnr sp of Border Round 1, yoh, pull up loop through sp to bring to front, insert hook from front to back in next sp, yoh, draw through loop on hook, cont along entire edge of Blanket, fasten off using nj. [208 per side; in total 836 ss]

#### **TO FINISH**

Weave in remaining ends and block to measurements if needed.

Start at blue corner 1 (8), 7 (8), 11 (9), 13 (10), 16 (8), 17 (7), 22 (11), 21 (5), 31 (9), 29 (8), 28 (7), 32 (10), 33 (12), 34 (9), 40 (5), 36 (7), 35 (6), 62 (7), 64 (7), 65 (6), 75 (7), 77 (5), 44 (8), 43 (12), 58 (7), 59 (12), 57 (7), 41 (8), 49 (7), 53 (12), 54 (9), 55 (5), 6 (6), 4 (10), 3 (7), 2 (3)

### Colour Placement Table: Organicon version

Border Round 3
Work 12 pc in each colour, except for the 4 corner colours which have 11 pc
<b>Start in red/pink corner</b> 248 (first 6 pc), 243, 246, 257, 258, 259, 254 (corner), 266, 263, 215, 231, 233, 234 (corner), 228, 213, 242, 211, 238, 223 (corner), 224, 245, 222, 244, 247, ending with final 5 pc sts in 248
