





Retro Daisy Baby Blanket

MATERIALS

Scheepjes Stone Washed Colour Pack

(78% Cotton, 22% Acrylic; 10 x 25g/65m) Grounding x 1 colour pack Chakras x 1 colour pack

Scheepjes Stone Washed (78% Cotton, 22% Acrylic; 50g/130m) 801 Moon Stone x 2 balls 4mm crochet hooks

GAUGE/TENSION

One Retro Daisy Granny Square measures 12.5 x 12.5cm (5 x 5in) after blocking

MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 67 x 80cm (261/4 x 301/2 in)

ABBREVIATIONS (UK TERMS)

[] number of sts on a given row/round ch(s) chain stitch(es)

ch1-sp chain 1 space(s): number denotes number of chains in chain space

dc double crochet

RS right side

ss slip stitch

PATTERN NOTES


Blanket consists of 30 motifs that will be joined, finally, a border is added. Pay close attention to gauge as it affects amount of yarn required. If in doubt, use a smaller crochet hook. Yarn from colour pack is exactly enough for Blanket. Retro daisy granny square is made with three colours: after working flower hart, alternate two colours. Let yarn you are not using hang loose. Watching a video for the specific motif might be helpful. Refer to the schematic and colour table for colour usage.

Instructions

RETRO DAISY GRANNY SQUARE

Crochet 30 <u>Daisy Flower Charity Squares</u>, designed by Krochet Krystal. From Round 10, follow pattern as written below.

SCHEMATIC 1: GRANNY SQUARE LAYOUT



Round 10 Ch1, 1dc in top of beg ch-3, 5dc, *1htr, 1tr, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in next st, 1tr, 1htr, 11dc; rep from * twice, 1tr, 1tr, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in next st, 5dc. [4 sides of 2 htr, 2 tr, 11 dc and 4 corners of 4 tr and ch-2 sp]

Round 11 Ch1, 10htr, *(2tr, ch2, 2tr) in corner, 19htr; rep from * twice, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in corner, 9htr. [4 sides of 19 htr and 4 corners of 4 tr and ch-2 sp]

Cut yarn, leaving a 15cm tail hanging and then fasten off using the invisible fasten off method.

Round 12 Using colour Moon Stone and starting with the small ball from the Colour Pack, join yarn with ss in any st, ch1, *1dc in each st to corner, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in corner; rep from * 3 times, cut yarn and fasten off using invisible fasten off method. [4 sides of 25 dc and 4 ch-2 sp]

ASSEMBLY

See Schematic 3: Blanket Layout and lay out all motifs as shown or as desired. First, join all vertical rows, indicated with a red line on the schematic. Then join all horizontal rows, indicated with a blue line on the schematic. Make sure to neatly align all motifs as you work.

With slip knot on hook, insert hook from front to back in back loop only of first dc in bottom left corner of right motif, then insert hook from front to back door back loop only of first dc in bottom right corner of left motif, yoh, pull up loop (first ss made), insert hook from front to back in back loop only of next dc of both motifs, yoh and pull up loop, continue in same way to last dc of this side. Place two new motifs above the just joined motifs and join them in same way as before. Continue until you have joined all 12 motifs together, fasten off at the end. Join all vertical rows together in same way until you have a blanket where you have only joined all vertical seams.

Then join all horizontal seams together in same way, working over the previously joined (vertical) seams when reaching corners.
Fasten off and weave in all ends.

BORDER

See Crochet Chart: Border.

Note: Work 1 dc extra at short sides to get an odd number of sts at end of round.

Round 1 (RS) Join colour Moon Stone with ss in corner, ch1 (does not count as s at begin of round), *(1dc, ch2, 1dc) in corner, 1dc in each s to corner (working 26 dc in each granny square and 1 dc in each seam); rep from * 3 times more, join with ss in first dc, turn. [long sides 163 dc, short sides 137 dc, 4 ch-2 sp]

Round 2 (WS) Ch1, *(1dc, ch1, skip next dc) to corner, (1dc, ch2, 1dc) in corner, ch1, skip next v; rep from * around, join with ss in first dc, turn. [long sides 83 dc and 82 ch-1 sp, short sides 70 dc and 69 ch-1 sp, 4 ch-2 sp]

Round 3 (RS) Ch1, 1dc in ch-sp, ch1, skip next dc, *(1dc, ch2, 1dc) in corner, ch1, skip next dc, (1dc in ch-sp, ch1, skip next dc) to corner; rep from * around, join with ss in first dc, turn. [long sides 84 dc and 83 ch-1 sp, short sides 71 dc and 70 ch-1 sp, 4 ch-2 sp]

Round 4 (WS) Ch1 (does not count as s at begin of round), *(1dc in ch-sp, ch1, skip next dc) to corner, (1dc, ch1, 1dc) in corner, ch1, skip next dc; rep from * around, join with ss in first dc. [long sides 85 dc and 84 ch-1 sp, short sides 72 dc and 71 ch-1 sp, 4 ch-2 sp].
Fasten off and join invisible

TO FINISH

Weave in all ends and block to measurements.


