MATERIALS

Scheepjes Stone Washed Colour Pack "Manifest" (78% Cotton, 22% Acrylic;

10 x 25g/65m)

Contains the following colours:

Yarn A 843 Realgar Red

Yarn B 842 Orange Calcite

Yarn C 833 Beryl

Yarn D 821 Pink Quartzite

Yarn E 820 Rose Quartz

Yarn F 835 Rhodochrosite

Yarn G 839 Eudialyte

Yarn H 808 Corundum Ruby

Yarn I 831 Axinite

Yarn J 804 Boulder Opal

3mm knitting needles

3.5mm crochet hook

8 wooden beads 14mm

8 wooden beads 5mm

GAUGE/TENSION

24 sts and 32 rows to measure 10 x 10cm (4 x 4in) over stocking st using 3mm needles

MEASUREMENTS

Finished Bunting: 425cm (167¼in) long Triangular Flag approx.: 12 x 15cm (7^3 4 x 6in) Rectangular Flag approx.: 12 x 13cm (7^3 4 x 5in)

ABBREVIATIONS

[] number of sts on a given row

ch chain or chain stitch(es)

dc double crochet (UK term, if using US terms, replace by **sc** single crochet)

dec(s) decrease(s)/decreased/decreasing
k knit

k2tog knit 2 sts together to dec by 1 st: insert needle knitwise into first 2 sts and knit them together

p pur

p2tog purl 2 sts together to dec by 1 st: insert needle purlwise into first 2 sts and purl them together

psso pass slipped st over

rep(s) repeat(s)

RS right side

skpo slip 1, knit 1, pass slipped st over **sk2po** slip 1, knit 2 together, pass slipped st

over

sl1 slip 1 st knitwise

sp2po slip 1, purl 2 together, pass slipped st over

st(s) stitch(es)

WS wrong side

yo yarn over

yrn yarn round needle

PATTERN NOTES

Bunting is made up of knitted rectangular and triangular-shaped Flags in various colours with tassels in between. Flags are knitted back and forth in rows and feature a seed stitch border. Bunting Line is crocheted. Beads are added to

Triangular Flags before weaving in ends.

INSTRUCTIONS

Rectangular Flag (make 1 in Yarns B, C, D, E, F, G, H)

Cast on 30 sts.

Row 1 (WS) (P1, k1) to end.

Row 2 (RS) (K1, p1) to end.

Rows 3-5 Rep Rows 1-2 once, then Row 1 once more.

Row 6 (K1, p1) twice, k22, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 7 (P1, k1) twice, p22, (p1, k1) twice.

Rows 8-43 Rep Rows 6-7 a further 18 times.

Row 44 P1, k1, (yo, k2tog, p1, k1) to end. [7

holes for Bunting Line]

Row 45 (P1, k1) twice, p22, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 46 (K1, p1) to end.

Row 47 (P1, k1) to end.

Cast off all sts.

Triangular Flag (make 1 in Yarns A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H)

Cast on 30 sts.

Row 1 (WS) (P1, k1) to end.

Row 2 (RS) (K1, p1) to end.

Row 3 K1, p1, (yrn, p2tog, k1, p1) to end. [7 holes for Bunting Line]

Row 4 (K1, p1) twice, p to last 4 sts, (k1, p1) twice

Row 5 (P1, k1) twice, k to last 4 sts, (p1, k1)

Rows 6-9 Rep Rows 4-5 twice.

Row 10 (K1, p1) twice, skpo, k to last 6 sts, k2tog, (k1, p1) twice. [28 sts]

Row 11 (P1, k1) twice, p to last 4 sts, (p1, k1) twice.

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Row 12 (K1, p1) twice, k to last 4 sts, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 13 Rep Row 11.

Rows 14-41 Rep Rows 10-13 a further 7 times. [14 sts]

Row 42 (K1, p1) twice, skpo, k2, k2tog, (k1, p1) twice. [12 sts]

Row 43 (P1, k1) twice, p4, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 44 (K1, p1) twice, k4, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 45 Rep Row 43.

Row 46 (K1, p1) twice, skpo, k2tog, (k1, p1) twice. [10 sts]

Row 47 (P1, k1) twice, p2, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 48 K1, p1, k1, skpo, k2tog, k1, p1, k1. [8 sts]

Row 49 P1, k1, p4, k1, p1.

Row 50 K1, p1, skpo, k2tog, k1, p1. [6 sts]

Row 51 P1, k1, p2tog, p1, k1. [5 sts]

Row 52 K1, sk2po, k1. [3 sts]

Row 53 Sp2po. [1 st]

Break yarn and pull tail through loop of st, leaving tail hanging to attach beads later.

Bunting Line

Using Yarn I and crochet hook, ch801.

Row 1 (RS) Starting in second ch, 1dc in each ch to end.

Fasten off.

Tassel (make 1 in Yarns A-I, and 8 in Yarn J)

Cut out a rectangle of 9 x 5cm ($3\frac{1}{2}$ x 2in) from cardboard and wrap yarn around the cardboard 25 times. Before slipping the yarn of the cardboard, take a 20cm (8in) length of yarn and wrap it around the looped ends at the top and tie a knot. Then slip the tassel of the cardboard. Take another 20cm-long piece of yarn and position it about 1cm under the top knot, tie the yarn around 5 times. Then cut the looped ends open and your tassel is finished.

TO FINISH

Block Flags to size.


Sew the beads to the bottom of the Triangular Flags as follows; first attach the large bead, then the small one and sew back through the large bead to secure, finish by weaving in the end.

See Schematic: Bunting Layout or use colour order of your choosing. Start in the centre of the Bunting Line and place all Flags on the line accordingly. Evenly place all Flags across the Bunting Line and attach Tassels in between and on both ends. Weave in all ends.
